2. COMPETITION INFORMATION

Number of coaches: One (1) for boy's team & One (1) for Girl's team

Number of Basketball Players: minimum six (6) players – maximum eight (8) players

16 teams for boy's tournament and **16** teams for girl's tournament

The tournament will begin with four (4) groups on 24/06/2009 and will end on 27/06/2009 with the final four at the Mets sports complex. Each group will consist of four (4) teams into which competing cities have been randomly assigned.

The top two teams (higher position) from each of the four groups will play in the quarter final. The winner's teams from the four games will play for the semi finals. The teams that they lose play for 3rd and 4th place and the winners for the gold medal in the final game.

For the needs of training, the athletes will be able to use the same venue (Mets) on 23 June 2009.

If two teams involved in a tie score at the end of playing time the game shall continue with as many extra time periods of two (2) minutes as is necessary to break the tie. Extra time period for the finals only will be three (3) minutes.

Basketball apparel:

Teams must have a minimum of two sets of shirts. Basketball shoes, socks, shorts, t-shirt. All equipment used by players must be appropriate for the game. Any equipment that is designed to increase a player's height or reach or in any other way give an unfair advantage is not permitted.

3. COMPETITION RULES

Each team may consist of between 6 - 8 players born in the years 1994, 1995, 1996 and 1997. Teams are allowed to proceed to unlimited number of substitutions according to the FIBA regulations. During a game only the coach and the players have to be in the field of play.

The ball will be 75-78cm & 600 – 650gr.

Ball size: 7 for boys and 6 for girls

Each game will consist of 2 periods of 20 minutes non stopping time except the last minute of each half.

Half time duration: 5 minutes

Warm up duration: 10 minutes

(2) Two points awarded for a win

(1) One for a loss

In the group phase that two or more teams have the same number of points then the winner (top team) will be decided by the following in this order:

- Head to head games
- Points difference
- Number of points scored divided by the points conceded (points ratio)

4. DISPUTES

Any disputes will be settled in compliance with FIBA rules and the clauses included in the I.C.G. Athens Sports Rules, and will be heard by the jury of Appeals, consisting of the Head of Referees, the ICG Technical Director Member and the Athens ICG Basketball Director.

5. DISCIPLINARY RULES

A player who has committed five (5) fouls personal or technical shall be informed thereof by the referee and must leave the game immediately.

Technical foul

Each team shall do its best to secure victory, but this must be done in the spirit of sportsmanship and fair play. Any deliberate or repeated non co-operation or non-compliance with the spirit of this rule shall be considered as a technical foul.

A team shall lose a game by default if, during the game, the team has fewer than two players on the playing court ready to play.

Game lost by forfeit:

The game is awarded to the opponents and the score shall be twenty to zero (20-0).

Athletes will be excluded from the games for indecent behavior, offence provided by words or actions, violent behavior, abusive language.

8. MEDICAL SERVICES

The technical meeting for Basketball competition will be held on the June 23rd, time and location will be determinate. If it's necessary, we will proceed to another technical meeting in order to ensure the quality of the Competition.

10. ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

All the teams must be in the court 45 minutes before the designated fixture. Teams (Coaches, Players) should arrive at Mets Sports Complex with the necessary accreditation. Any delegation has to comply with any indication made by the venue staff, without creating any kind of problem to other teams. For any issue or protest, the Head of Delegation has to contact the competition manager immediately. If anything negative is observed we request immediate report to the department responsible person.
