The competition will take place in two (2) football fields (Akademia-Platonos & Alepotrypa)

Number of coaches: One for each boy's team & one for each girl's team

Number of footballers: minimum 7 players – maximum 9 players

16 teams for boy's tournament & 16 teams for girl's tournament

2. COMPETITION INFORMATION

The tournament will begin with (4) four groups on **24/06/2009** (group stage phase) and will end on **27/06/2009** with the final. Each league will consist of (4) four teams into which competing cities have been randomly assigned. Teams will play with the all other teams in their league once only.

The (2) two teams with the higher position from each league advance to the Knockout stages.

For the needs of training, the athletes will be able to use the same venues (Alepotrypa and Academia-Platonos) on 23 June 2009.

In the tournament (group stage phase) that two (2) teams have the same number of points then the winner will be decided by the following in this order:

- Head to head
- goal difference
- most goals
- goals conceded

The (8) eight winners of the group stage contest the knockout stage. This phase is played under the cup system (knock out).

If two teams involved in a tie score during the knockout stage (same number of goals), extra time of two periods of 5 minutes shall be played. If during extra time both teams score no goals (same number of goals) kicks from the penalty mark determine which team (city) qualifies to the next phase. No substitutes are allowed to take any penalties. Teams may choose their best five penalty takers from the 6 players that finished the fixture. If the score are level after five shots, penalties from this point onwards are sudden death.

Football apparel:

Football shoes (Players must wear football boots without metal studs), socks, shorts, t-shirt, captain's armband, goalkeeper gloves, shin guards (required for all participants).

Each team has to bring two different kits in order to be able to participate in the football tournament.

3. COMPETITION RULES

Squad size consists of (6) players: (5 players, including 1 Captain), 1 goalkeeper

Each team may consist of between 7 and 9 players born in the years 1994, 1995, 1996 and 1997.

Substitutions may be only made during a break in play (substitute zone) and with referee's consent. Teams are allowed to proceed to unlimited number of substitutions. At the beginning of the game the choice of ends shall be decided by the toss of a coin between the two team captains. During a game only the coach and the players has to be in the field of play.

Pitch size will be 55 - 50 X 45 – 40

The ball will be a size No 5

Each game will consist of 2 halves of 20 minutes each

Half time duration: 5 minutes

Warm up duration: 10 minutes

(3) Three points awarded for a win

(1) One point for a draw

(0) Zero for a loss

4. DISPUTES

Any disputes will be settled in compliance with FIFA rules and the clauses included in the ICG Athens Sports Rules, and will be heard by the jury of Appeals, consisting of the Head of Referees, the ICG Technical Director Member and the Athens ICG Football Director.

5. DISCIPLINARY RULES

Player's who receive a yellow card will be sent to the bench for two minutes.

Typical yellow card offences include:

Unsporting behavior, dissent by words or actions

Players sent off (red card) for any reason will be suspended for the all next team's fixtures.

Typical red card offences include:

Serious foul-play, violent conduct, second yellow, abusive language.

If a team is permanently reduced to 4 players due to sending offs, the game will end and the match will be awarded 2-0 to their opponents.

Athletes will be excluded from the games for indecent behavior, offence provided by words or actions, violent behavior, abusive language.

All participants will receive a certificate from the Organizing Committee Athens 2009.

Gold medal: 1st tournament team (city)

Silver medal: 2nd tournament team (city)

Bronze medal: 3rd tournament team (city)

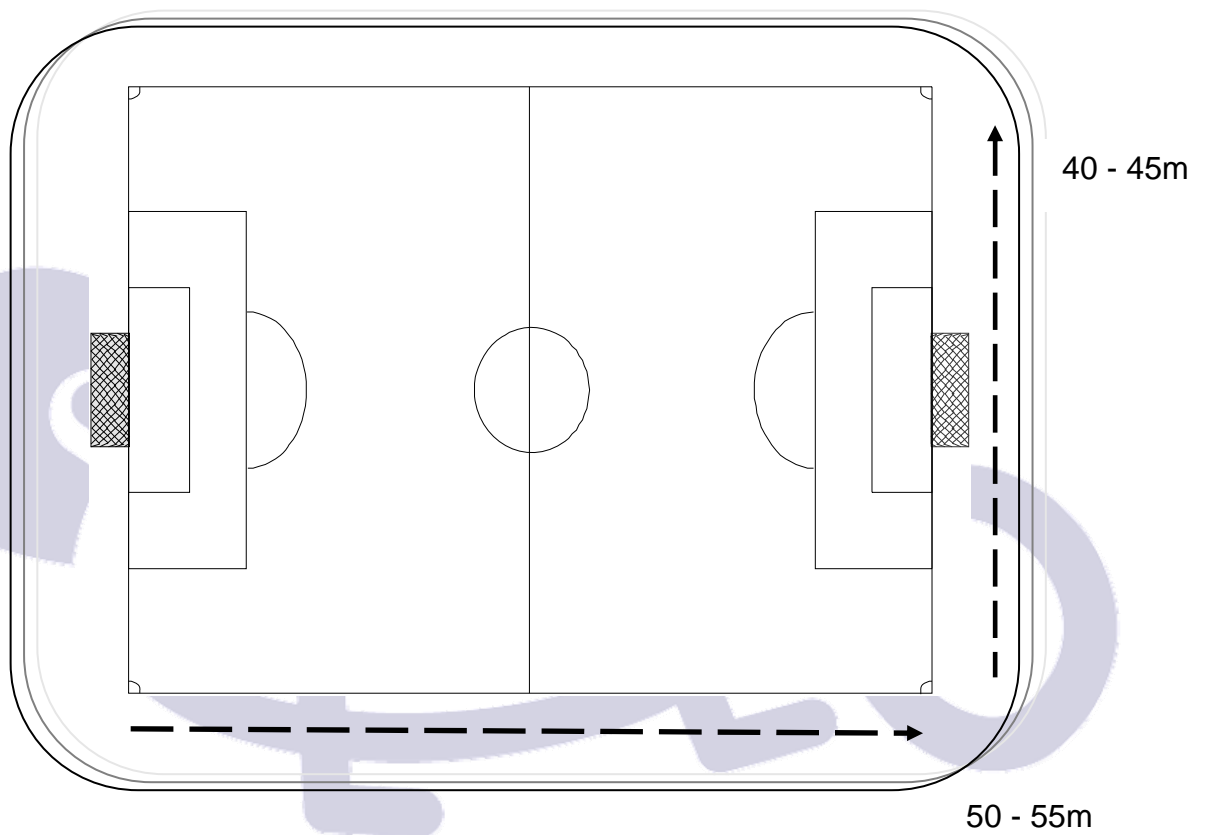

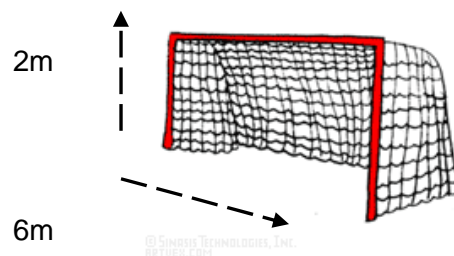

8. MEDICAL SERVICES

During the games a full medical service (Doctor, physiotherapist, medical equipment and ambulance) will be available at the football venues.

The first football technical meeting will be held on the June 23rd, time and location will be determinate. If it's necessary, we will proceed to another technical meeting in order to secure the quality of the Competition.

10. ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

All the teams must be in the venue 30 minutes before the designated fixture. Teams (Coaches, Players) should arrive at the venue with the necessary accreditation. Any delegation has to comply with any indication made by the venue staff, without creating any kind of problem to other teams. For any issue or protest, the Head of Delegation has to contact the competition manager immediately. If anything negative is observed we request immediate report to the department responsible person.

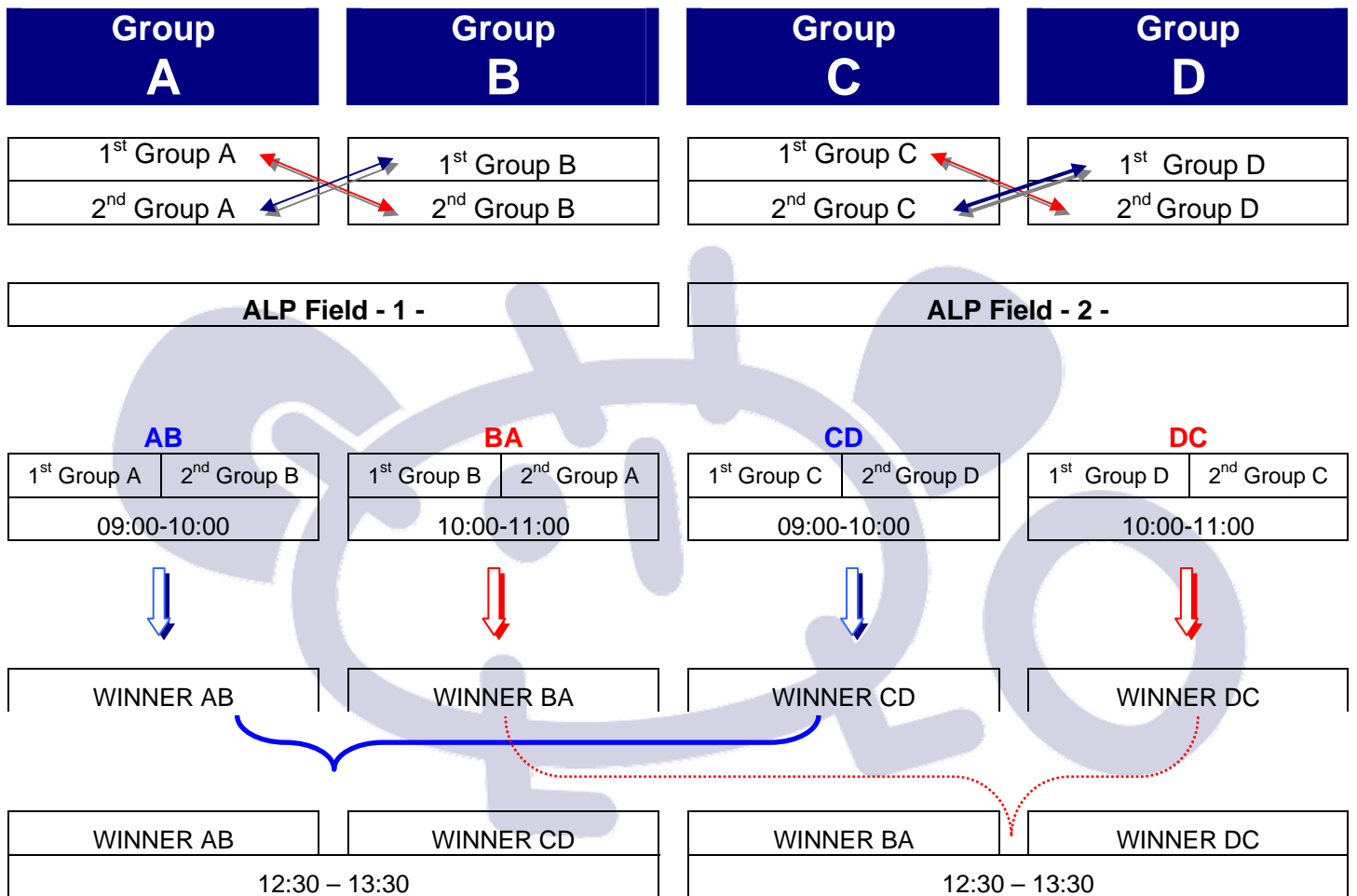

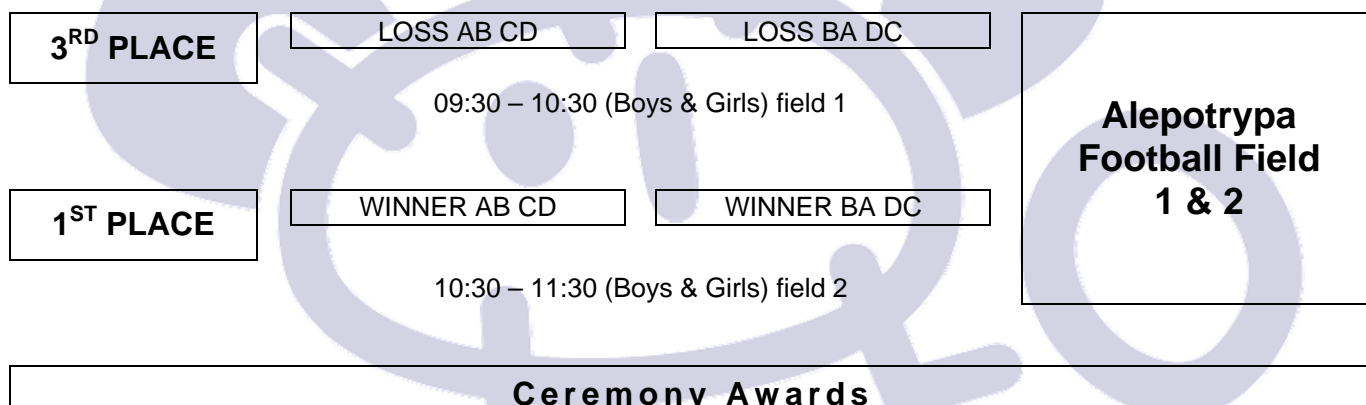
