Number of coaches: One (1) for each boy's team and one (1) for each girl's team.

Number of volley ball players: minimum six (7) players – maximum nine (9) players

Twelve (12) teams for boy's tournament & sixteen (16) teams for girl's tournament

2. COMPETITION INFORMATION

The tournament will begin with three (3) pools on 24/06/2009 (group stage phase – 1st round) for boy's, four (4) pools for girl's and will end on 27/06/2009 with the final stage at the Goudi and Strefi Volleyball Courts. Each pool will consist of four (4) teams. The teams will play each other in a round – robin format, meaning each team play 3 matches in the first round (24-25-26.06.2009).

At the end of the first round, the top two (2) teams in each pool (Girls tournament) advance to the 2nd round (pre-semifinal). At the end of the first round, for Boys tournament, the top two teams and also the best two third advances to the 2nd round.

For the needs of training, the athletes will be able to use the same venues (Strefi and Goudi courts) on 23 June 2009.

If two (2) or more teams have the same number of match points, the tie will be broken by point's ratio. The number of points won during the three matches, divided by the number of points lost.

In the group phase (1st round) the match won by the team that wins two (2) sets

- The winner of each match receives two (2) match points
- The loser receives one (1) point

Girl's tournament (pre-semi final)

In the pre semi final round the 1st team from Pool A will play against the 2nd form the Pool B. The 2nd team from Pool A will play against the 1st from Pool B. The 1st team from Pool C will play against the 2nd form the Pool D. The 2nd team from Pool C will play against the 1st from Pool D. The matches won by the teams that win two (2) sets.

Boy's tournament (pre-semi final)

In the pre semi final round the 1st team from Pool A will play against the 2nd form the Pool B. The 2nd team from Pool A will play against the second best 3rd. The 1st team from Pool C will play against the first best 3rd. The 2nd team from Pool C will play against the 1st from Pool B. The matches won by the teams that win two (2) sets.

VOLLEYBALL

In the Final round will follow the same format as above, meaning that the match won by the team that win two (2) sets.

A player's equipment consists of a jersey, shorts, socks and sport shoes.

The color and the design for the jersey, shorts and socks must be uniform for the team except for the Libero. Player's jersey must be numbered from 1 to 18. The team captain must have on his / her jersey a stripe of 8 X 2 cm underlining the number on the chest.

Each team has to bring two different kits in order to be able to participate in the football tournament.

3. COMPETITION RULES

Squad size consists of 6 players ready to play. Participants must be born in 1994, 1995, 1996 and 1997.

The rules of the tournament will be FIVB rules modified for tournament play.

The playing area includes the playing court and the free zone. The playing court is a rectangle measuring 18 X 9m. The free playing space shall measure a minimum of 7m in height from the playing surface. During a game only the coach and the players has to be in the field of play.

The court: 18 X 9m.

The ball standards: circumference 65 – 67

Weight 260 – 280

Inside pressure 0,30 – 0,325 kg/cm²

Height of the net: 2,30 for boys – 2,20 for girls

Time out duration: 30 sec

Warm up duration: 15 minutes

In the deciding set, once the leading team reaches eight (8) points, the teams change courts without delay and the player positions remain the same.

Four (4) substitutes is the maximum permitted per team per set.

Team must be in the court 30 minutes before the designated fixture.

VOLLEYBALL

A set is won by the team which first scores 21 points (except the deciding set) with a minimum lead of two (2) points. In the case of 20-20 tie, play is continued until a two (2) point lead achieved. The deciding set is played to 15 points with a minimum lead of two (2) points.

Before the match, the first referee carries out a toss to decide upon the first service and the side of the court in the first set.

4. DISPUTES

Any disputes will be settled in compliance with FIVB rules and the clauses included in the ICG Athens Sports Rules, and will be heard by the Jury of Appeals, consisting of the Head of Referees, the ICG Technical Director Member and the Athens ICG Volleyball Director.

5. DISCIPLINARY RULES

If a team refuses to play or does not appear on the playing court it is declared in default and forfeits the match with the result 0-2 on the first, the second and third round for the match and 0-21 for each set.

Athletes will be excluded from the games for indecent behavior, offence provided by words or actions, violent behavior, abusive language.

8. MEDICAL SERVICES

9. TECHNICAL MEETING

The first technical meeting will be held on the June 23rd, time and location will be decided. If it's necessary, we will proceed to another technical meeting in order to ensure the quality of the Competition.

10. ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

All the teams must be in the court - venue 45 minutes before the designated fixture. Teams (Coaches, Players) should arrive at the Goudi and Strefi Volleyball Courts with the necessary accreditation. Any delegation has to comply with any indication made by the venue staff, without creating any kind of problems to other teams. For any issue or protest, the Head of Delegation has to contact the competition manager immediately. If anything negative is observed we request immediate report to the department responsible person.
