Number of coaches: One for each male team and one for each female team

Number of athletes: minimum 2 – maximum 6 per gender

Total number of athletes (including athletes with disabilities): 120 per gender

2. COMPETITION INFORMATION

The competitions will begin with preliminaries on 24th June. The finals will be held on 25th and 26th at the Panellinos G.S. track & field stadium.

For the needs of training, the athletes will be able to use the same venue on 23rd June 2009.

Athletes may compete in two (2) individual events plus one (1) relay. All teams could participate in one relay for children's without disabilities or in the relay of the project "Together" (4X80m. Relay, three (3) athletes and one (1) athlete with disabilities).

Children's with vision impairment (blindness) could participate if they belong in the categories T-11, T-12, T-13.

Athletes with disabilities

- Number of athletes with disabilities for each team maximum 2
- Total number of athletes with disabilities (class **T11, T12, T13**): 16 athletes per gender.
- Number of Coaches (escorts): One for each team
- It's not necessary, for the participating city to register athletes with disabilities

The children's with disabilities in running events may participate with one athlete of their team as a guider runner.

In relay event (4x80m.) the children with disability will be the anchor man. No baton will be used on the takeover marks. The takeover will take part into the relay zone by one touch hand to the next runner each time.

Each City which wants to register an athlete with disability is required to provide the classification card (document) issued by the competent National Committee.

In case that we don't receive any of the above documents we will reject the registration.

3. COMPETITION RULES

Competitions sports

Individual Events

100m.

80m. for children with vision impairment (blindness)

800m. girls

High Jump

Relay events:

4X100m. Relay

4X80m., Relay mixed for children/athletes with vision impairment
competing together with children's/athletes without disabilities

Starting points:

Shot Put Boys 4 kg. Girls 3 kg.

High Jump Boys 1,25 m. Girls 1,20 m.

Athlete's apparel:

Racing suits are required for all competitors.

Each delegation may consist of between 2 - 6 athletes (including athletes with disabilities) born in the years 1994, 1995, 1996 and 1997.

During the competition only the athletes are allowed to be in the field. Coaches must be in the warm up area or outside of the field.

4. DISPUTES

Any disputes will be settled in compliance with IAAF rules (and IPC Athletic rules) and the clauses included in the ICG Athens Sports Rules, and will be heard by the jury of Appeals, consisting of the Head of Referees, the ICG Technical Director Member and the Athens ICG Track & Field Director.

5. DISCIPLINARY RULES

Athletes will be excluded from the games for indecent behavior, offence provided by words or actions, violent behavior, abusive language.

All participants will receive a certificate from the Organizing Committee Athens 2009

Gold medal: 1st athlete

Silver medal: 2nd athlete

Bronze medal: 3rd athlete

10. ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

All the delegations must be in the stadium 2 hours before the designated fixture. Teams (Coaches, Players) should arrive at Panellinos G.S. Stadium with the necessary accreditation. Any delegation has to comply with any indication made by the venue staff, without creating any kind of problem to other teams. For any issue or protest, the Head of Delegation has to contact the competition manager immediately. If anything negative is observed we request immediate report to the department responsible person.
